

Rep Council Meeting

Sept 5, 2017

Meeting was called to order at 3:55 PM.

Minutes were read. Ashley made a motion to approve the minutes with a correction. The minutes said Kandace decided not to serve. That was incorrect information. She is willing to serve, however, Hemmerling needs to have a new election. Jan seconded the motion. Motion was approved with correction.

Treasurer's Report

Reports for April, May, June and July were presented. Dimi made a motion to accept the reports. Rob seconded. Motion carried and treasurer's reports were accepted.

Negotiations

We are waiting for impasse to be filed by the district. Negotiations remain at a stand-still. Even though it was agreed that the BTA and District would file impasse together, Rose from CTA suggested we wait for the district to file impasse.

Arbitration

*Years of Service: We are waiting for an arbitration date in a month or so.

*Transfers from Nicolet

*Payment for moving grievance is at Level II and may go to arbitration.

Loss of Fair Share

Yohn v. California Teachers Association was filed on behalf of 8 teachers in California. If this case passes through the Supreme Court, public employees will no longer be required to pay union dues. This lawsuit was refiled with the new Supreme Court Justice, after the death of Justice Scalia.

Stipend Positions

Most BTA members have not taken stipend positions, until the district agrees to negotiate the unfair labor practice. Some people have kept or resumed their stipend positions. In order to have an impact with the district and the board, we should continue to boycott those positions.

Organizing

Regarding BTA shirts. Ashley sent out options for a vote. She didn't receive enough responses. The shirts will still need to be ordered.

Grievance

A grievance has been filed at the BHS about how to use the additional 16 hours of professional development.

PAC

Community letters have been written. Branding cards have been ordered. Yard signs have been ordered. PAC has met with CTA rep, Patti Bailey, who is working with us to get publications finished and in the mail.

Leadership Conference

Everyone who is attending must call Bob/Bobby by Sept. 19, 2017 to confirm. Jan made a motion to include PAC members in the conference. LuAnn seconded the motion. The motion carried.

New Business

Dinner Theater flyer was handed out by James. The tickets are \$30, including dinner, to be paid by BTA for BTA members. Ashley made a motion to buy all seats for October 28, 2017, open to BTA members first and any tickets left over will be open to family members. Jan seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Jan's sister-in-law will hold a card making class. She can have about 20 people per class. The cost will be \$10-15 including snacks. BTA can provide the snacks. Jan will talk to her about doing two class sessions in a day, and set a date.

Hoffer's BTS Night is next Wed., Sept. 9, 2017 at 5:30. We will plan a BTA rally at that sight.

CTA Reps will be going to each site to discuss concerns with the membership.
